



CAVES of DRACH & EAST AREA *full day*

DESCRIPTION:

This is a full-day guided trip.

Once we have picked up the clients at their hotels or pick-up points, we will drive through Mallorca's inland area, and at about 10:00, we will arrive in Montuiri, a perfect example of one of the inland Mallorca villages. There, we will visit the famous Pearl factory, where they will give us a brief explanation, and we will see the exhibition area, which demonstrates the process of making the artificial pearls.

After that, we will drive to the East area, having free time in the beautiful seaside town of Porto Cristo. There is a beach nearby so you can sunbathe or go swimming. If not, there is a marina for a stroll.

At 12:45, we will go to a picnic restaurant for lunch time. Lunch is not included.

After this, we will go to the Caves of Drach, the eighth wonder of the world. The visit will take 1 hour including the classical music concert on Lake Martel, the highlight of the visit. When the concert is over, the clients will have the chance to cross the lake on boats.

On the way back, there will be a brief stop in Manacor at a shop where the clients can see the olive wood carving technique, quite popular in the island.
